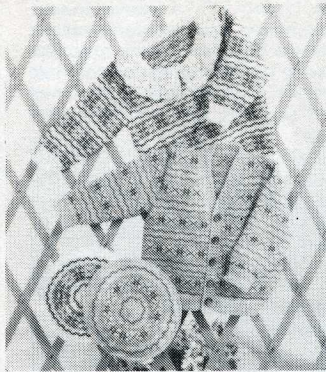


pattern 8



MAIN TENSION

30 sts and 40 rows to 10cm measured over Fair Isle patt (tension dial approx 7=MT). Tension must be matched exactly before starting garment.

ABBREVIATIONS

See page 59.

NOTE

Knit side is used as right side. Measurements given are those of finished garment and should not be used to measure work on the machine.

PUNCHCARD/MYLAR SHEET PATTERNS

Punch cards or mark mylar sheet before starting to knit. Punchcard 1 used for Fair Isle patterning. Punchcard 2 used for lace patterning on sweater collar.

PATTERN NOTE

Lace pattern: Card punched and marked for Brother machines. Other machines use fashion/multi transfer lace.

Knitmaster and Silver Reed machines: move arrows for return rows (ie. for K only rows), down by 2 rows throughout.

Fair Isle pattern: worked on Fair Isle setting throughout, changing colours in both feeders as follows:

Note: where MC/A shown, then colour at left of line is used in feeder 1/A and colour at right in feeder 2/B. In example, MC would be used in feeder 1/A whilst A would be used in feeder 2/B.

BOY'S

K2 rows MC/A
K2 rows MC only

K1 row MC/B
K1 row B only
K2 rows B/MC
K2 rows C/D
K1 row C/E
K2 rows C/D
K2 rows B/MC
K1 row B only
K1 row MC/B
K2 rows MC only

K2 rows MC/A

K4 rows MC only
These 25 rows form one complete patt.

GIRLS'S

K2 rows MC/A
K2 rows MC only

K1 row MC/B
K1 row B only
K2 rows B/MC
K2 rows MC/D
K1 row MC/A
K2 rows MC/D
K2 rows B/MC
K1 row B only
K1 row MC/B
K2 rows MC only

K2 rows MC/A

K4 rows MC
These 25 rows form one complete patt.

SPECIAL NOTE

Crochet cast on edge was used for lace collar. This technique is often explained in your basic manual. If not, work thus:

Using WY and MT, cast on and K a few rows ending CAL. Using nylon cord, K1 row. CAR. Push all Ns to HP. Thread MC through yarn brake but not in carr. Make a slip knot and slip on to first N at left. Starting at left edge, take latch tool and hold loop of slip knot behind latch. Wrap yarn around left end N. Insert latch tool between the first and second Ns on left from below and catch the yarn with the latch tool. Keeping the yarn in the hook of the latch tool, pull yarn through chain loop and slip hook behind latch, making first st. Move tool between next 2 Ns. Rep the procedure of catching the yarn and forming the loops along the row until the last N. Place loop on latch tool on to hook of N. Thread up carr and K the first row.

MACHINES: These instructions are written for standard gauge punchcard or electronic machines with ribber. We used a Brother 950i

YARN: Spectrum Vermont 4 ply Perlé

FIBRE CONTENT: 100% Acrylic

COLOUR: We used Shade 875 Arctic Grey (MC), Shade 877 Pot Pourri (A), Shade 874 Aster (B), Shade 852 Serpentine (C), Shade 862 Cream (D) and Shade 861 Red (E) for boy's set.

We used Shade 855 Apricot (MC), Shade 880 Wine (A), Shade 877 Pot Pourri (B), Shade 856 Honey (C) and Shade 862 Cream (D) for girl's set

SIZES

To suit chest 41[46:51:56]cm.
Finished measurement 46[51:56:61]cm.
Length 24.5[28:31.5:34.5]cm.
Sleeve seam 13[15:18:20]cm.
Figures in square brackets [] refer to larger sizes; where there is only one set of figures, this applies to all sizes.

MATERIALS

Spectrum Vermont 4 ply Perlé.
2 x 100g balls in MC.
1 x 100g ball in each of A, B C and D.
Small amount of E.

CARDIGAN

5 buttons.

BERETS

Narrow elastic.

GARMENT WEIGHS

For size 51cm
Sweater: 140g.
Cardigan: 140g.
Beret: 40g.

**GIRL'S SWEATER
BACK**

With RB in position, set machine for 1x1 rib. Push 71[77:83:93] Ns on MB and corresponding Ns on RB to WP. Arrange Ns for 1x1 rib. CAR. Using MC, cast on and K3 tubular rows. Using MT-3/MT-3, K12 rows. Transfer sts to MB and inc 1 st. 72[78:84:94] sts.

Set RC at 000. Using MC and MT, K1 row. Insert punchcard 1 and lock/program patt 1 on first row. Set carr to select/memorise for patt and K1 row. Release punchcard and set carr for patt (see patt note). K until RC shows 50[60:70:78].

SHAPE ARMHOLES

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row, 3[3:4:5] times in all. 56[62:66:74] sts**. K until RC shows 86[100:116:128]. Set carr for st st and K1 row. WK over centre 26[28:30:32] sts (push Ns at each side to HP and set carr for HP). Push 15[17:18:21] Ns at opposite side to carr to UWP and WK. Set carr so HP Ns will K and WK over rem 15[17:18:21] sts.

FRONT

Work as given for back to **. K until RC shows 70[74:88:100].

SHAPE FRONT OPENING

Note patt row and position in colour sequence. Using nylon cord, K sts at left of '0' by hand taking Ns down to NWP. Cont on rem sts at right for first side. K9 rows.

SHAPE NECK

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next row, K1 row. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row, K1 row. Cast off 2 sts at beg of next and foll alt row, K1 row. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row, 1[2:3:4] times in all. K until RC shows 86[100:116:128]. Set carr for st st and K1 row. WK.

CAL. Reset punchcard to noted row and lock/program patt on noted row. Unravel nylon cord from sts at left, bringing Ns down to WP. Set carr to select/memorise for patt without K and take to left. Release punchcard and set carr for patt (see patt note). Reset RC at 70[74:78:88:100]. Keeping colour sequence correct from noted position, work left side to correspond with right.

SLEEVES

With RB in position, set machine for 1x1 rib. Push 45[49:51:53] Ns on MB and corresponding Ns on RB to WP. Arrange Ns for 1x1

rib. CAR. Using MC, cast on and K3 tubular rows. Using MT-3/MT-3, K12 rows. Transfer sts to MB and inc 1 st. 46[50:52:54] sts. Using MT, K1 row. Insert punchcard 1 and lock/program patt on 8th[8th:8th:6th] row. Set carr to select/memorise for patt and K1 row. Release punchcard and set carr for patt (see patt note).

Set RC at 000. Work in colour sequence from appropriate row (see patt note). K until RC shows 4[4:5:5]. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th[4th:5th:5th] row, 8[10:10:13] times in all. 62[70:72:80] sts. K until RC shows 40[48:60:68].

SHAPE TOP

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row, 4[6:8:10] times in all. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 6 rows. Cast off rem 22[26:24:28] sts.

COLLAR

Push 136[144:160:172] Ns to WP. Using WY and MT, cast on and K a few rows ending CAL. Using nylon cord, K1 row. Using D, work crochet cast on (see special note) over nylon cord. Using MT, K2 rows (K1 row for Toyota/Knitmaster/Silver Reed machines). Insert punchcard 2 and lock/program patt 2 on first row. Set carr to select/memorise for patt and K1 row (Brother machines, use lace carr to go to right to select, do not K another row). Release punchcard and set carr for patt (see patt note). Set RC at 000. K until RC shows 18. Set carr for st st and K1 row. WK.

TO MAKE UP

Block pieces to correct measurements, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry. Lightly block and steam press collar to give scalloped edge. Graft shoulder seams. To join collar to neck edge — push 34[36:40:43] Ns to WP. With wrong side of right front facing, pick up 21[22:25:27] sts and hang on to first 21[22:25:27] Ns at left, pick up 13[14:15:18] sts along back neck and hang on to rem Ns. With wrong side of collar facing, pick up sts from below WY and hang 2 sts on each N, starting at left edge of collar (3 sts on each N and some collar not yet picked up). Using A, K through each group of sts by hand and cast off. When you reach the centre back, don't break yarn, but transfer the last

group of sts on to the first N. Pick up rem sts from neck edge and collar and cast off in the same manner. Turn collar to outside. Neaten front opening. Set in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams. Work 2 plaited cords approx 20cm long and attach to front opening. Tie in a bow.

**CARDIGAN
(MAIN BODY WORKED IN ONE
PIECE UP TO ARMHOLES)**

MAIN BODY

With RB in position, set machine for 1x1 rib. Push 141[153:165:185] Ns on MB and corresponding Ns on RB to WP. Arrange Ns for 1x1 rib. CAR. Using MC, cast on and K3 tubular rows. Using MT-3/MT-3, K12 rows. Transfer sts to MB and inc 1 st. 142[154:166:186] sts.

Set RC at 000. Work as given for back sweater until RC shows 50[60:70:78].

SHAPE ARMHOLES

Note patt row and position in colour sequence. Using 2 spare lengths of MC, cast off 6 sts at each side of centre '0' over Ns 34-39[37-42:39-44:44-49]. Using 2 nylon cords, K sts for the 2 fronts by hand, taking Ns down to NWP. Cont over rem 66[72:76:86] sts. K2 rows. Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row, 3[3:3:4] times in all. 56[62:66:74] sts. K until RC shows 86[100:116:128]. Set carr for st st and K1 row. Set carr for HP and push 15[17:18:21] Ns either side of centre 26[28:30:32] sts to HP. WK over centre 26[28:30:32] sts. CAR. Push 15[17:18:21] Ns (in HP) nearest carr to UWP and WK. CAL work as given for first side.

LEFT FRONT

CAL. Unravel nylon cord over 32[35:39:44] Ns at right by hand, taking Ns down into UWP. Reset punchcard to noted row and lock/program patt on noted row/ Set carr to select/memorise without K and take to right. Reset RC at 50[60:70:78]. Release punchcard and set carr for patt (see patt note). Keeping colour sequence correct from noted position

SHAPE NECK

Place a marker at right edge. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next and every foll alt[alt:3rd:3rd] row, 6[5:15:16] times. At the same time, continue with armhole shaping. K1 row. Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row, K1 row. Dec 1 st at armhole edge

on next and every foll alt row, 2[2:4:5] times in all.

SIZES 41 AND 46cm ONLY

When RC shows 61[69], K2 rows. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next and every foll 3rd row, 7[9] times in all.

ALL SIZES

15[17:18:21] sts rem. K until RC shows 86[100:116:128]. Change to st st and K1 row. WK.

RIGHT FRONT

CAR. Unravel nylon cord over 32[35:39:44] Ns at left by hand, taking Ns down into UWP. Reset punchcard to noted row and lock/program patt on noted row/ Set carr to select/memorise without K and take to right. Reset RC at 50[60:70:78]. Release punchcard and set carr for patt (see patt note). Keeping colour sequence correct from noted position work right front to correspond with left.

SLEEVES

Work as given for sweater.

BUTTONHOLE BAND

Graft shoulder seams.

With RB in position, set machine for 1x1 rib. Push 87[99:109:119] Ns on MB and corresponding Ns on RB to WP. Arrange Ns for 1x1 rib. CAR. Using MC, cast on and K3 tubular rows.

Set RC at 000. Using MT-3/MT-3, K4 rows. Work 5 evenly spaced buttonholes over first 44[52:57:63] sts (at right for boy's and left for girl's), by transferring 2 sts — one from each bed, on to their adjacent Ns, leaving empty Ns in WP. K5 rows. Transfer sts to MB. Using MT, K1 row. With wrong side facing, hang the left front and half of back neckband evenly on to Ns. Using TD10, K1 row. Cast off using latch tool.

BUTTON BAND

Work as given for buttonhole band, omitting buttonholes.

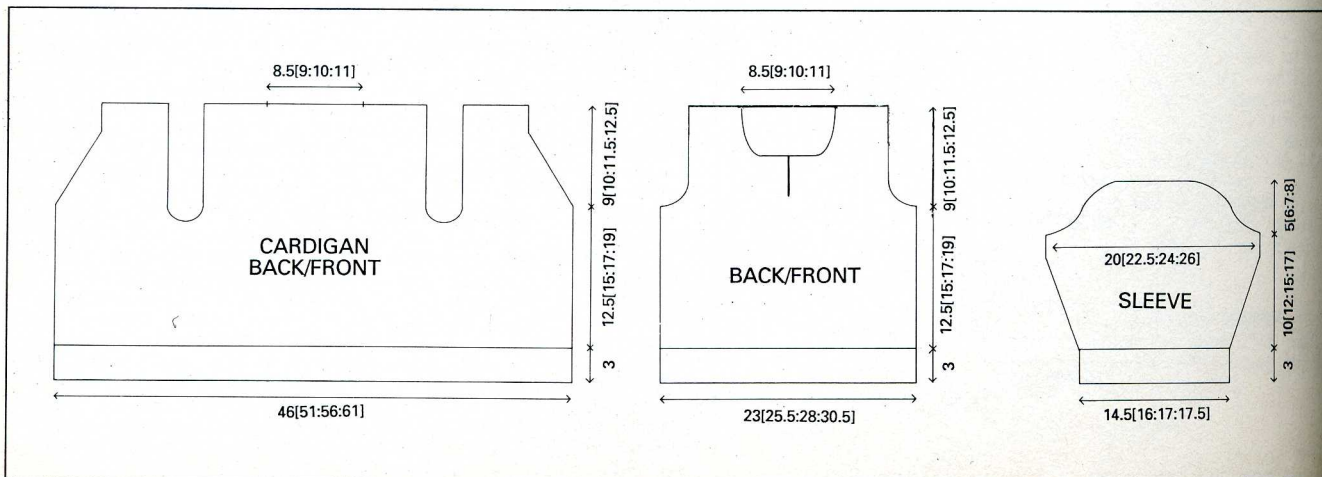
TO MAKE UP

Block pieces to correct measurements, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry. Join sleeve seams. Set in sleeves. Join neckband at centre back. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes. Work one row double crochet along lower edges of front bands.

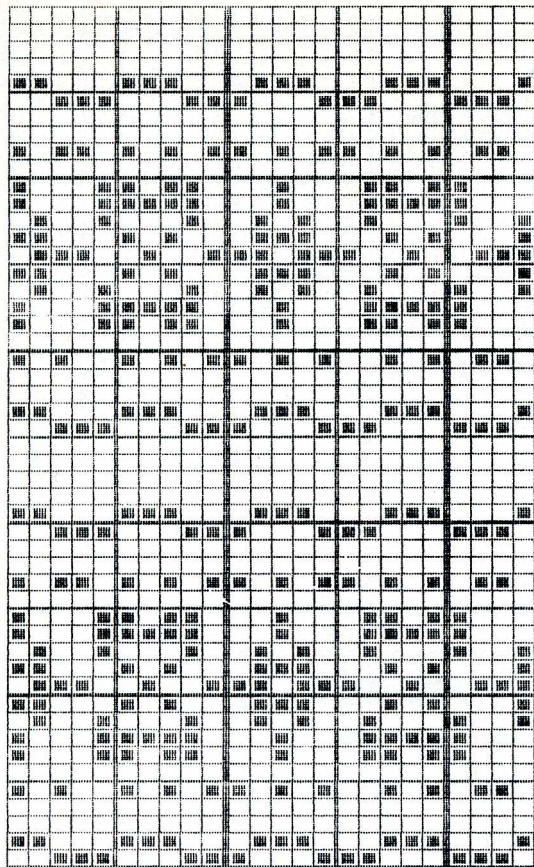
BERET

RIBBED SECTION

Push 93 Ns to WP. Using WY and MT, cast on and K a few rows ending CAR. Using MC



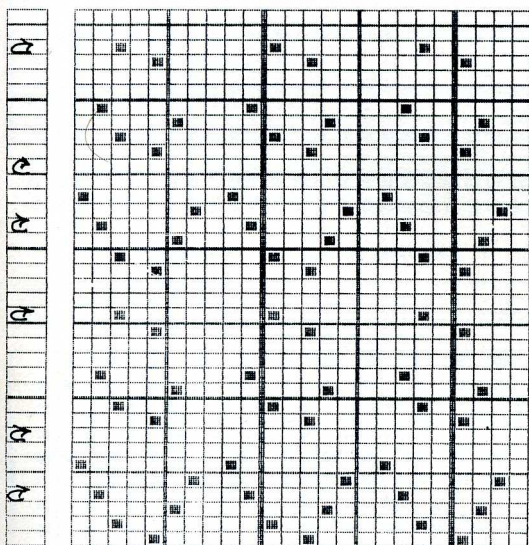
PUNCHCARD 1

Pattern marked for Brother and Toyota machines

Silver Reed and Knitmaster move return arrows down by 2

and MT, K3 rows. Push RB into WP and transfer sts for 1x1 rib. Insert comb and weight evenly. Using MT-3/MT-3, K40 rows. Transfer sts to MB. Using MT, K1 row. Turn a hem by picking up loops from first row worked in MC and hang evenly along the row. Remove WY. K2 rows. WK.

SECOND SECTION

Push 93 Ns to WP. Turn work over so that the K side of hem is facing. Set carr for HP and always taking the yarn around the first inside N in HP, push 19 Ns at opposite side to carr to HP on next 4 rows. Push all Ns at opposite side to carr to UWP on next 2 rows. All Ns in WP. Insert punchcard and lock/program patt on first row. Set carr to select/memorise for patt and K1 row. Release punchcard and work in patt (see patt note) throughout. K2 rows. Set carr for st st and K1 row. WK.

Work a second piece of ribbing and second section alike.

THIRD SECTION

Push 93 Ns to WP. With wrong side facing, pick up loops from last row worked in MC and hang on to Ns. Place 2 sts on each N for first 46 Ns, hang last st on next N. Hang first st of second piece on same N, then hang 2 sts on each N to end. Remove WY.

Set RC at 10. Insert punchcard and lock/program patt on 5th row. Set carr to select/memorise for patt. Using MC, K1 row. Release punchcard and work in patt for 9 rows. Set carr for st st and K1 row. WK.

FOURTH SECTION

Push 47 Ns to WP. With wrong side facing pick up sts from below WY and hang 2 sts on each N to last N, 1 st on last N. Remove WY. Reset RC at 21. Using MC, K1 row. Reset punchcard/program patt on first row and lock. Set carr to select/memorise for patt and using MC, K1 row. Release punchcard and work 2 rows in patt. Set carr for st st and K1 row. WK.

FIFTH SECTION

Push 24 Ns to WP. Pick up sts from below WY and hang 2 sts on each of first 23 Ns and 1 st on last N. Reset RC at 26. Using MC, K5 rows and WK.

SIXTH SECTION

Push 12 Ns to WP. With wrong side facing, pick up and hang last row worked in MC, 2 sts on each N. Remove WY. Reset RC at 31. Using MC, K4 rows and WK.

SEVENTH SECTION

Push 6 Ns to WP. Pick up sts as for sixth section. Remove WY. Reset RC at 35. Using MC, K4 rows. Break off yarn, leaving a long end. Thread yarn through loops of sts and release from machine. Pull up and fasten off securely.

TO MAKE UP

Join seams. Leave an opening in ribbed edge for inserting elastic. Insert elastic and adjust for head size of baby. Secure ends and close opening. Place beret over a plate measuring approx 20cm across. Steam lightly and allow to dry.
