

Pattern 13



GARMENT WEIGHS

For size 51cm:

Cardigan: 140g.

Leggings: 100g.

Sweater: 100g.

MAIN TENSION

30 sts and 42 rows to 10cm measured over st st (tension dial approx 5).

27 sts and 69 rows to 10cm measured over (tuck) patt 2 (tension dial approx 5).

33 sts and 65 rows to 10cm measured over (rib) patt 1 (tension dial approx 3/3 = MT-2/MT-2).

Tensions must be matched exactly before starting garment.

ABBREVIATIONS

See page 67.

NOTE

Tuck (purl) side is used as right side for jacket and sweater.

Knit side is used as right side for leggings.

Measurements given are those of finished garment and should not be used to measure work on the machine.

PUNCHCARD PATTERN

Punch card before starting to knit.

Note: Check basic patt set before punching as this is a common card in some sets.

PATTERN NOTE

PATTERN 1

English rib worked thus:

MB set to K throughout, RB set to tuck from left to right and K from right to left throughout.

Using C, K20 rows.

Using MC, K20 rows.

These 40 rows form patt and are rep throughout.

PATTERN 2

Carr set for tuck stitch throughout.

Using MC, K4 rows.

Using C, K2 rows.

These 6 rows form patt and are rep throughout.

CARDIGAN

BACK

With RB in position, set machine for 1x1 rib. Push 91[97:99:103] Ns on MB and corresponding Ns on RB to WP. Arrange Ns for 1x1 rib. CAR. Using MC, cast on and K3 tubular rows. Using MT-3/MT-3, K10 rows.

Set RC at 000. Set carr for patt (see note) and work in patt 1 throughout *. Using MT-2/MT-2, K until RC shows 90[100:110:120]. Place a marker at each edge. K until RC shows 168[182:194:208]. Transfer sts to MB. Place markers at each end of centre 31[33:33:35] sts. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

With RB in position, set machine for 1x1 rib. Push 65[67:69:71] Ns on MB and corresponding Ns on RB to WP. Work as given for back to *.

MACHINES: These instructions are written for standard gauge punchcard or electronic machines with ribber.

We used a Brother 910 with 850 ribber

SIZES

To suit chest 46[49:51:53]cm.

JACKET

Finished measurement 55[59:61:63]cm.

Length 28.5[30.5:32.5:34.5]cm.

Sleeve seam 16.5[17.5:19.5:21.5]cm.

SWEATER

Finished measurement 54[57:60:63]cm.

Length 29[31:33:35]cm.

Sleeve seam 17[18:20:22]cm.

LEGGINGS

Inside leg length 20[22:25:28]cm (excluding cuffs).

Figures in square brackets [] refer to larger sizes; where there is only one set of figures, this applies to all sizes.

MATERIALS

Amberyarn Academy.

1 x 400g cone in each of MC and C.

CARDIGAN

6 buttons.

LEGGINGS

2 buttons.

Elastic for waist.

Using MC and MT-2/MT-2, K until RC shows 6[6:10:10].

BUTTONHOLES

Work on left front for boy's version.

Make buttonholes by transferring 8th and 28th sts from left edge on to their adj sts on RB, leaving empty Ns in WP. ** K 24[24:30:30] rows. Work buttonholes over same sts as before **. Rep from ** to **, once more. K until RC shows 60[60:80:80].

SHAPE NECK

Dec 1 st at left (right for left front) edge on next and every foll 3rd row, 35[35:36:24] times in all. K 0[0:0:3] rows. Dec 1 st at left (right for left front) edge on next and every foll 4th row, 0[0:0:13] times in all. 30[32:33:34] sts. K until RC shows 168[182:194:208]. Transfer sts to MB. Cast off.

LEFT FRONT

Work as given for right front, omitting buttonholes.
Note: Boy's version, add buttonholes but count sts from right edge and not left.

SLEEVES

With RB in position, set machine for 1x1 rib. Push 55[59:63:67] Ns on MB and corresponding Ns on RB to WP. Work as given for back to *. Using MT-2/MT-2, K 7[8:9:10] rows. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 7th[8th:9th:10th] row, 12[12:12:11] times in all. 79[83:87:89] sts. K until

RC shows 90[100:110:124]. Transfer sts to MB and cast off.

FRONT BANDS

Push 80[86:90:96] Ns to WP. With right side of front facing, pick up 9 sts along welt, 7 sts along each stripe below shaping, 9 sts along each diagonal stripe above neck shaping and 5[2:8:5] sts along top part stripe. * Using MC and MT-1, K5 rows. Using MT+2, K1 row. Using MT-1, K7 rows and WK.

BACK NECKBAND

Push 30[32:32:34] Ns to WP. With right side facing, pick up back neck edge and hang evenly on to Ns. Complete as given for front band from * to end.

TO MAKE UP

Join shoulder seams. Fold bands in half on to right side and backstitch through last row worked in MC. Set in sleeves between markers. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

LEGGINGS

(WORK TWO LEGS ALIKE)
Push 116[122:128:134] Ns to WP. Using WY and MT, cast on and K a few rows ending CAR. Set RC at 000. Using MC and MT, K until RC shows 84[92:104:118].

SHAPE CRUTCH

Set RC at 000. Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at

each end of next and every foll alt row, 4 times in all. 104[110:116:122] sts. K until RC shows 76[84:92:100].

WAISTBAND

Using MT+3, K1 row. Using MT-1, K10 rows. Using MT+3, K1 row. Using MT-1, K10 rows. Turn a hem by picking up loops of first row worked at MT+3 and hang evenly along the row. Using MT+5, K1 row. Cast off using latch tool.

ANKLE CUFFS

With RB in position, set machine for 1x1 rib. Push 77[81:85:89] Ns on MB and corresponding Ns on RB to WP. Arrange Ns for 1x1 rib. CAR. Using MC, cast on and K3 tubular rows. Using MT-3/MT-3, K48 rows. Transfer sts to MB. With wrong side facing, pick up sts from bottom leg, below WY and hang on to Ns, dec 39[41:43:45] sts evenly along the row, to fit. Remove WY. Using MT+5, K1 row. Cast off using latch tool.

STRAPS

(WORK TWO ALIKE)

With RB in position, set machine for 1x1 rib. Push 13 Ns on MB and corresponding Ns on RB to WP. Arrange Ns for 1x1 rib. CAR. Using MC, cast on and K3 tubular rows. Using MT-2/MT-2, K4 rows. Make buttonhole by transferring centre st on MB on to its adj N on RB, leaving empty N in WP. K until strap measures

35[38:41:44]cm. Transfer sts to MB. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Join inside leg seams. Join crutch seams at centre front and centre back, leaving a small opening in waistband. Insert elastic, adjust to fit and fasten off securely. Close waistband opening. Sew on straps. Sew on buttons to inside of waistband casing. Turn up leg cuffs.

SWEATER BACK

With RB in position, set machine for 1x1 rib. Push 73[77:81:85] Ns on MB and corresponding Ns on RB to WP. Arrange Ns for 1x1 rib. CAR. Using C, cast on and K3 tubular rows. Using MT-3/MT-3, K2 rows **. Using MC, K8 rows. Using C, K4 rows. Transfer sts to MB. Inc 1 st. 74[78:82:86] sts. Insert punchcard and lock on first row. Set carr to select/memorise for patt and using MT, K1 row. Release punchcard and set carr for patt (see note).

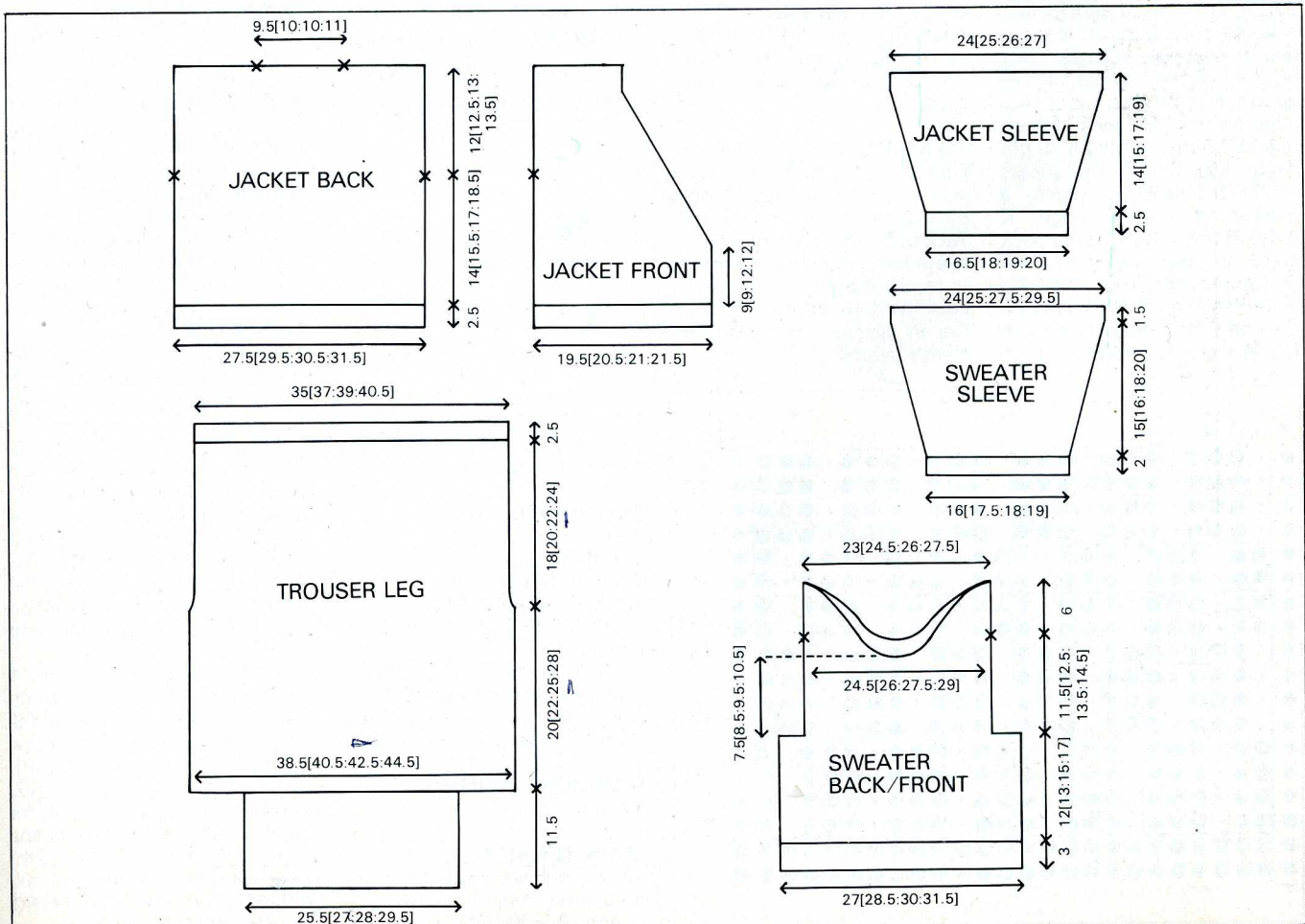
Set RC at 000. Work in patt throughout and K until RC shows 82[90:104:118].

SHAPE ARMHOLES

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows **. 66[70:74:78] sts. K until RC shows 144[160:180:200].

SHAPE NECK

Note punchcard patt row and



position in stripe sequence. Using a separate piece of MC, cast off 14[14:16:16] sts at centre. Using nylon cord, K 26[28:29:31] sts at left by hand taking Ns down to NWP. Cont on rem 26[28:29:31] sts at right for first side. K1 row. Cast off 2 sts at neck edge on next and foll alt row, K1 row. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next and every foll alt row, 5[9:7:11] times in all. *At the same time*, place marker at outside edge when RC shows 162[178:198:218]. K 4[4:3:3] rows. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next and every foll 5th[5th:4th:4th] row, 8[6:9:7] times in all, K1 row. Cast off 3 sts at neck edge on next and foll alt row, K1 row. Cast off rem 3 sts. CAR. Reset punchcard to noted row and lock. Unravel nylon cord over sts at left, bringing Ns down to WP. Set carr to select/memorise for patt without knitting and take to left. Release punchcard, set carr for patt and K left side to correspond with right.

FRONT

Work as given for back to **. K until RC shows 134[148:170:190]

SHAPE NECK

Using a separate piece of MC, cast off 12[12:14:14] sts at centre. Make a note of punchcard patt row and position in colour sequence. Using nylon cord, K 27[29:30:32] sts at left by hand, taking Ns down to NWP. Cont on rem 27[29:30:32] sts at right for first side. K1 row. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row, K1 row. Cast off 2 sts at beg of next and foll alt row, K1 row. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next and every foll alt row, 4[7:5:9] times in all. *At the same time* when RC shows 162[178:198:218], place a marker at outside edge. K 4[4:3:3] rows. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next and every foll 5th[5th:4th:4th] row, 10[9:12:10] times in all. K 1[2:1:1] rows. Cast off 2 sts at beg of next and foll alt row, K1 row.

Cast off rem 2 sts. CAR. Reset punchcard to noted row and lock. Unravel nylon cord over sts at left, bringing Ns down to WP. Set carr to select/memorise for patt without knitting and take to left. Release punchcard, set carr for patt and K left side to correspond with right.

SLEEVES

With RB in position, set machine for 1x1 rib. Push 43[47:49:51] Ns on MB and corresponding Ns on RB to WP. Work as given for back to **. Using MC, K4 rows. Using C, K4 rows. Transfer sts to MB. Inc 1 st. 44[48:50:52] sts. Insert punchcard and lock on third row. Set carr to select/memorise for patt and using C, K1 row. Release punchcard and set carr for patt (see note). Set RC at 000. Work in patt throughout. K until RC shows 10[10:10:9]. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 10th[10th:10th:9th] row, 10[10:12:14] times in all. 64[68:74:80] sts. K until RC shows 104[110:124:138]. Place a marker at each edge. K10 rows. Set carr for st st and using MT+2, K1 row. Cast off.

FRONT NECKBAND

Push 100[102:104:108] Ns to WP. With right side of front facing, pick up neck edge and hang evenly on to Ns. Using C and MT-1, K6 rows. Using MT+2, K1 row. Using MT-1, K7 rows and WK.

BACK NECKBAND

Push 87[89:92:96] Ns to WP. Work as given for front neckband, picking up back neck edge.

TO MAKE UP

Fold bands in half on to right side and finish by backstitching through last row worked in C. Tack back and front together at shoulders, matching markers at centre shoulder point, so that back overlaps front on outside. Set in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams.
